

## Psalm 5 (NKJV)

1 Give ear to my words, O LORD,  
Consider my meditation.

2 Give heed to the voice of my cry,  
My King and my God,  
For to You I will pray.

3 My voice You shall hear in the morning, O LORD;  
In the morning I will direct it to You,  
And I will look up.

4 For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness,  
Nor shall evil dwell with You.

5 The boastful shall not stand in Your sight;  
You hate all workers of iniquity.

6 You shall destroy those who speak falsehood;  
The LORD abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.

7 But as for me, I will come into Your house in the multitude of  
Your mercy;  
In fear of You I will worship toward Your holy temple.

8 Lead me, O LORD, in Your righteousness because of my  
enemies;  
Make Your way straight before my face.

9 For there is no faithfulness in their mouth;  
Their inward part is destruction;  
Their throat is an open tomb;  
They flatter with their tongue.

10 Pronounce them guilty, O God!  
Let them fall by their own counsels;  
Cast them out in the multitude of their transgressions,  
For they have rebelled against You.

11 But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You;  
Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them;  
Let those also who love Your name  
Be joyful in You.

12 For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous;  
With favor You will surround him as with a shield.

## Sermon Notes: Psalm 5 - "A God Saturated Life"

### 5 Characteristics of a God Saturated Life

#### 1) A H \_\_\_\_\_ Prayer Life (verses 1-3)

→ 3 things David wanted God to hear

- A) His Meditation – verse 1
- B) His Cry – verse 2
- C) His Voice – verse 3

#### 2) A B \_\_\_\_\_ World-view (verses 4-6)

→ 3 things David was confident about

- A) God rejects the wicked – verse 4
- B) God refuses the arrogant – verse 5
- C) God resists the deceitful – verse 6

#### 3) An I \_\_\_\_\_ Dependence on God (verses 7-8)

→ 2 declarations David makes

- A) I will fear God – verse 7
- B) I will follow God – verse 8

#### 4) A R \_\_\_\_\_ Attitude Toward Sin (verses 9-10)

→ 2 points David makes about his enemies

- A) They are godless – verse 9
- B) They are guilty – verse 10

#### 5) A M \_\_\_\_\_ Worship (verses 11-12)

→ 2 pleas David makes to the righteous

- A) Let the righteous resound – verse 11a
- B) Let the righteous rejoice – verse 11b-12
